

## Radiology

Radiographs on small and large animals, along with wildlife and research projects, are performed in the imaging section of the Veterinary Teaching Hospital. It is located in the large animal clinic in the Veterinary Teaching Hospital. Mobile xray units are used in the surgical suites and for ambulatory exams in the field.

Radiology consists of three imaging rooms equipped with Kodak CR (computerized radiography) and Eklon DR (digital radiography) units. A fluoroscopy unit is located in the special procedures room.

With the addition of the on-line PACS system, the section has moved to a film-less environment. All radiographs may be viewed on a computer. Although a laser printer is available for hard copy films, monitors for viewing on-line images are available throughout the facility and in the operating rooms.
