

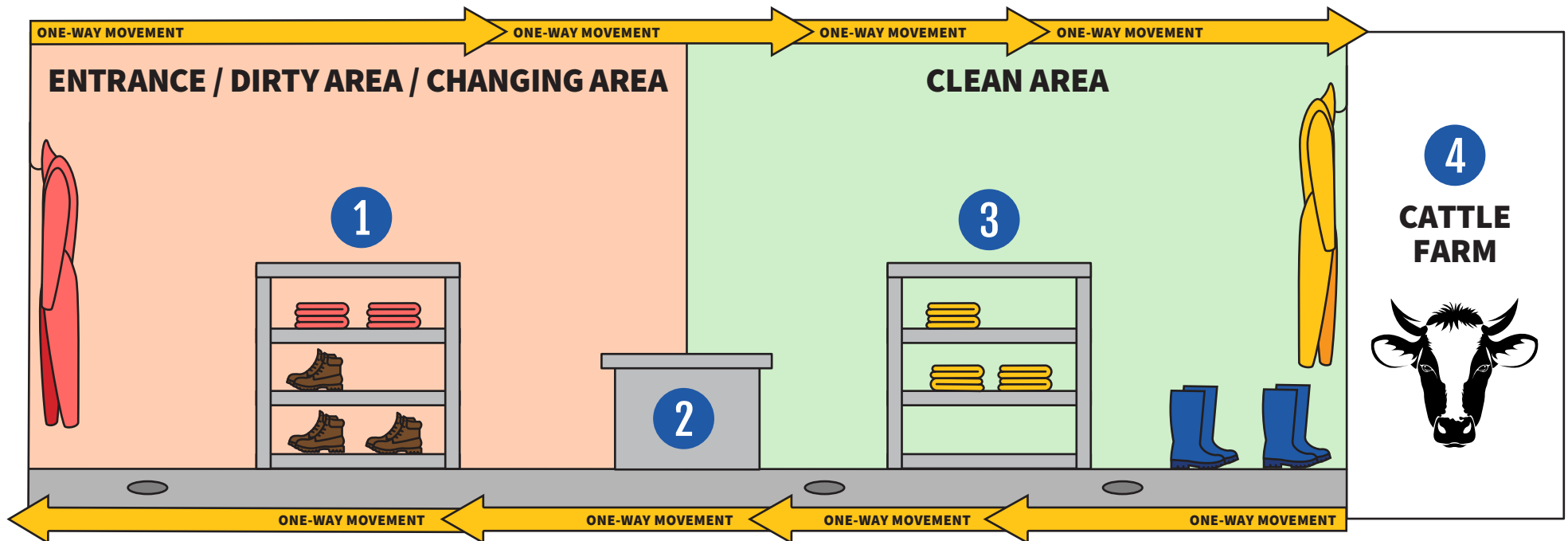

- 1 Remove your shoes (along with disposable booties, if any) and coat (or removable clothes) and place them on the designated shoe and coat racks in the changing area.
- 2 Cross the bench or bar without touching your feet on the floor of the changing area.

- 3 Step into the clean area and put on the farm-specific boots and coveralls.\*
- 4 Enter the cattle farm.

**NOTE:** All the movement should be one-way with no turning back in between.

\* Disposables can also be worn if farm-specific coveralls and boots are not available.
