Waterways/ Surface Water



- Prevent access to running or stagnant water at pastures
- Test waterways and surface water for pathogens and chemicals



Pasture Management

- Avoid sharing or renting pastures
- Identify contaminated soils/pastures and prevent using them
- Plow under manure before cattle use the pasture
- · Control helminths at pasture
- Isolate sick animals and only allow of healthy animals into pastures





Wildlife

Prevent and control wildlife access to pasture by a fence, dogs, or other barriers





- · Limit visitor access to pasture
- Visitors must wear clean clothes and boots and sanitize their hands



Pests

Control ticks, mosquitoes, rodents, and other vectors on farms









- Limit access of off-site vehicles to animal areas
- Separate access routes should be provided for vehicles



Neighboring Herd

Prevent contact with neighboring farm animals at pasture by a fence or other barriers
