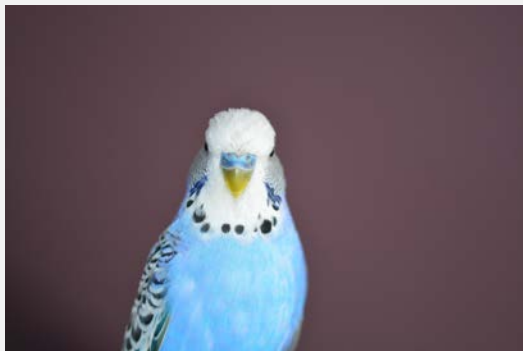

18! The “thumb” is called the dewclaw and some dogs have all 4 but most commonly they lack the ones on their rear feet

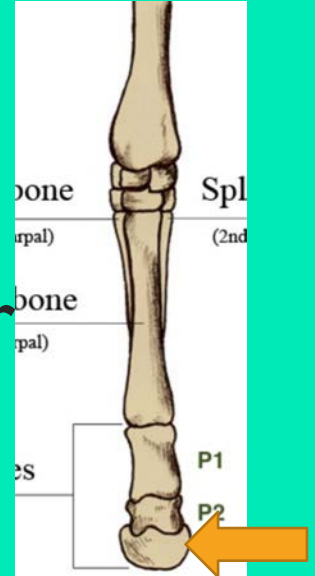
CAN DOGS EAT VEGETABLES?

Some vegetables can be safely incorporated into your pet's diet with the help of your veterinarian. However, there are a few vegetables that are **toxic to dogs**, including garlic and onions, so avoid those!

HOW MANY TOES DOES A HORSE HAVE?

Four total (one on each leg)

Yes horses actually walk on four
toes--how crazy!



HOW MANY LUNGS DO SNAKES HAVE?

One! Most snakes only have one functional, simple lung--usually the right one. The left is usually smaller or absent

HOW MANY TEETH DO DOGS HAVE?

Dogs: Adults have 42

Puppies have 28

Humans: Adults have 32

Babies have 20
