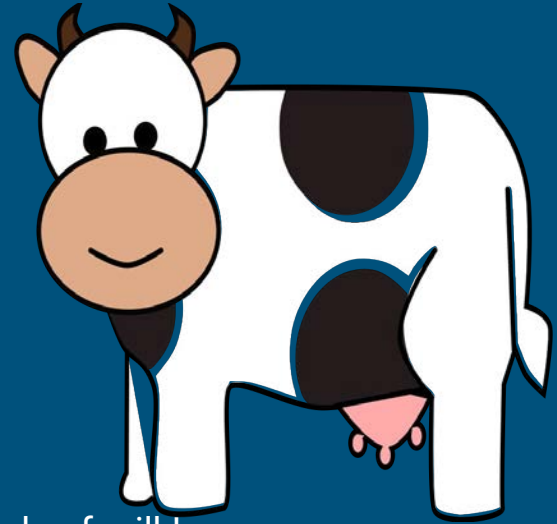


Dairy Cow Quiz

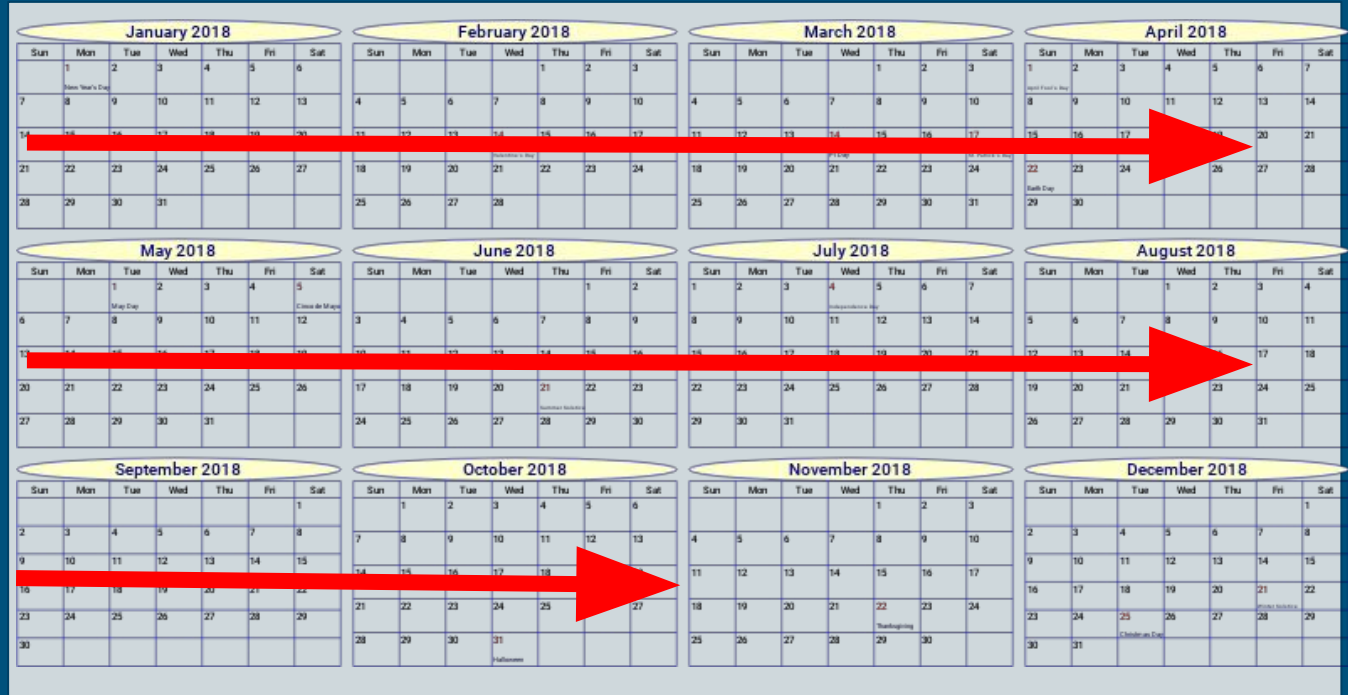
