What is SAVMA?

The American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA) is a national organization that advocates for the veterinary profession, and each veterinary school has their own student chapter which advocates for its students under a similar model. The Student AVMA (SAVMA) consists of an Executive Board and a House of Delegates (HOD), and the formation of a national organization of veterinary students has enabled what were once isolated student chapters to function effectively as a single unit on the national scene. The Student AVMA coordinates student chapter functions, promotes the exchange of ideas and information among students, and represents its members in matters that concern them, both as students and as future veterinarians.

SAVMA Membership Information

You can only order items from the following form if you become a member of the Illinois SAVMA Chapter

Option 1: Lifetime SAVMA Membership

This is a 4-year membership with a one-time dues payment of \$150. Keep in mind dues may increase from year to year, so purchasing the 4 year membership guarantees you will not have to pay again even if dues increase. Also, in order to receive the AVMA graduation packet with many discounts (including discounted rates for the first 2 years out in practice), you need to be a member in good standing for 4 full years (see the membership form for all of the benefits of becoming a member). You can pay for this option along with your supplies order.

Option 2: Yearly Basis

This is a one-year \$50 membership, and by selecting this option you will be responsible for going online and registering for SAVMA (Student American Veterinary Medicine Association). You will NOT need to send a check for dues or journal subscriptions to us as you will pay online. You will still need to send the completed order form and a check if you choose to purchase the first-year supplies (order form included in this document). Option 3: No membership

By opting-out of SAVMA membership, you understand you cannot purchase items through this sale and will not receive the benefits listed on pages 1-2 of this document. You will not be able to pay a discounted price for certain college functions.

Illinois SAVMA Chapter Supplies Order Form

Membership Registration Required to Purchase

To ease your transition to your first year of veterinary school, we facilitate the ordering of first-year supplies. You **WILL** need all of these items, but you do not have to purchase them through this order. However, these items are the standard for classes and clinics and we highly recommend them!

Items required for first year that are included in this order form: Scrubs, Boots/Boot Covers, Bib Coveralls, Digital thermometer, Penlight, Surgical Pack

Other required items that are not sold through this form: Gloves and Scalpel Blades for Anatomy Dissection (you will receive information with the option to order these through Surgery Club later in the summer), Khakis and Plain-colored Polos (for specific clinical rotations second quarter), Watch (other than a smart watch), Calculator, Stethoscope

Other items you may want to purchase for rotations in October: Small Notebook, Hoof pick

Item Descriptions

- Surgical Pack
 - Bandage Scissors 4.5"
 - Brown-Adson Forceps 7x7 Teeth
 - Crile Hemostat Forceps Curved 5.5"
 - Crile Hemostat Forceps Straight 5.5"
 - Operating Scissors Sharp-Blunt Points 4.5"
 - Scalpel Handle 3 with Scale
 - Scalpel Handle 4
 - Spencer Stitch Scissors with Hook Tip
 - Taylor Neurological Hammer
 - Mayo Hegar Needle Holder Straight Serrated Jaws 6"
 - These are the instruments you will need for clinical rotations.
 - If you are LEFT-HANDED: You will probably be just fine using all of these instruments left-handed, but the Needle Holder may be uncomfortable. If you switch between right and left-handed, we recommend trying to use instruments with your right hand. If you are strictly left-handed, please contact me (Erica Greene iscavmasale@gmail.com) and we can discuss other options.
 - The surgical pack is \$50.
- Penlight
 - Reusable, with a replaceable battery and light. This may be used on clinical rotations. The penlight is \$3.
- Thermometer
 - Quick read, flexible tip

- PLEASE NOTE: Due to recent medical supply shortages, the thermometers will likely not come in with the rest of the supplies. We will get these to your mailboxes as soon as we receive them, and you should not need it until clinical rotations begin in October.
- The thermometers will be \$10.
- iClicker
 - The use of iClickers during first year has varied over the last few years, so you may or may not need this first year, but will definitely use it second year.
 - The iClicker will be \$40.
- Boots
 - Tingley® 14” (“knee-high”) Black, washable, low-tread, slip-on over shoe work boot. These will go on OVER your shoes and fasten on the side. Find your normal shoe size below and follow it to the right to get your size in these boots. This is the preferred style for clinical rotations but any washable boot that goes higher than your ankle is acceptable.
 - The boots are \$28.95.

- Scrubs
 - For clinical rotations, you will need scrubs. You may want to wear scrubs in anatomy lab as well, but these can be any scrubs (old, stained, other clinic logos). For clinical rotations, your scrubs need to be plain and may not have any other logos on them. The brand name is fine (ex: the “Grey’s Anatomy” logo on a small tag would be fine, but your scrubs cannot advertise another clinic or veterinary/medical product). This is why we offer generic scrubs to get your collection started. These are plain, blue scrubs.
 - The top is UNISEX, so please keep this in mind when choosing your size.
 - The women’s pants are drawstring with elastic waist, flared leg, and pockets. Some students have said these may run a little large and long, so if you are between sizes consider sizing down.
 - The men’s pants are drawstring with elastic waist, zippered fly, with traditional and cargo pockets as well as a buttoned back pocket.

- Bib Coveralls

- **NAVY BLUE** coveralls will be required for food animal clinical rotations starting with the Class of 2024. Previous classes have been permitted to wear a wide variety of colors, and most have green. Older students may be selling their green coveralls for an affordable price which you may or may not be permitted to wear for first year activities and extracurriculars, but by the time your class (2024) reaches fourth year clinics you **will** be required to wear navy. If you are buying coveralls for the first time, we highly recommend buying navy. They do not have to be this style, but they should be navy blue (denim is not permitted).
