General Information:

Application Deadline: July 15, 2021. Awardees will be notified by October 1, 2021.

The awarded funds are determined by the NA PRRSS Travel Fellowship Awards Selection Committee and are given in the form of a reimbursement check (or wire transfer for international recipients) for allowable expenses up to the award amount. Please keep all original detailed receipts for expenses submitted for reimbursement.

Allowable expenses (up to the award amount) include:

- NA PRRS Symposium registration •
- Round-trip coach class (best available economy class) airfare from the airport nearest your home to • Chicago, IL
- If driving to conference, automobile mileage/tolls at the State reimbursement rate •
- Up to two night's stay (discounted conference rate only) at the conference hotel •
- Local travel expense (taxi, bus, train, etc.) to and from Chicago airport to the conference hotel when flying to Chicago from your home base. **

** For taxi, bus, train transportation a detailed original receipt must be submitted showing the location of departure and arrival, date, cost, etc.

The names of awardees are posted on the NA PRRSS website and published in the printed program and proceedings.

Application Criteria:

Applicants must:

- Be a graduate student or post-doctoral fellow working on PRRS, emerging/foreign animal diseases of • swine.
- Be the primary author on an abstract covering original research findings. The research described in the abstract must be presented as a poster during the NA PRRSS/NC-229. A few selected awardees will also give an oral presentation.
- Attend all meeting sessions.
