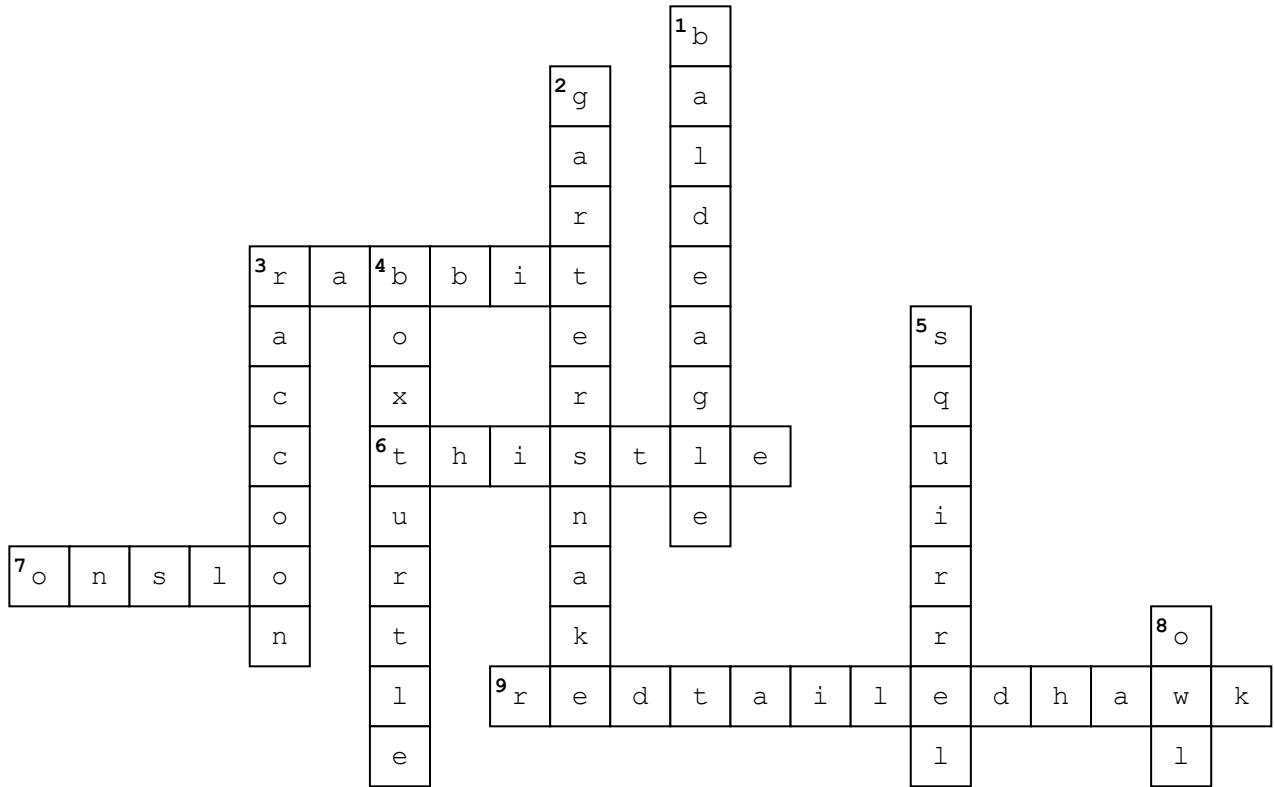


# Wildlife Crossword!
