

# **Client Medication Schedules**



The University of Illinois Veterinary Teaching Hospital Medication Dispensary can create a customized medication schedule for your pet. A medication schedule can be extremely beneficial when your pet takes many medications, some medications require food and others require an empty stomach, and/or there is a concern for drug interactions. Our goal is to make treating your pet as simple as possible

Our pharmacists will review all the medications your pet takes and provide you with a handout that includes appropriate days and times for you to give them medications.
