How to Reconstitute Antibiotic Beyond Use Date: Azithromycin

Step-By-Step: Azithromycin 40mg/ml 15 ml

- 1. Shake bottle to loosen powder
- 2. Use syringe to measure 9ml of water and add into Azithromycin bottle
 - *Powder may clump be sure to reconstitute all powder well
- 3. Insert bottle adaptor (if applicable) and place cap on bottle
- 4. Shake vigorously
- 5. Use Azithromycin within 10 days. Store at either room temperature or preferred refrigeration (but not required)
- 6. Always shake well prior to administration

How to Reconstitute Antibiotic Beyond Use Date: Clavamox

Step-By-Step: Clavamox 62.5mg/ml 15 ml (Amoxicillin-Clavulanate)

- 1. Shake bottle to loosen powder
- 2. Use syringe to measure 14ml of water and add into Clavamox bottle
 - *Powder may clump be sure to reconstitute all powder well
- 3. Insert bottle adaptor (if applicable) and place cap on bottle
- 4. Shake vigorously
- 5. Use Clavamox within 10 days. Refrigeration is required
- 6. Always shake well prior to administration

How to Reconstitute Antibiotic Beyond Use Date: Fluconazole

Step-By-Step: Fluconazole 10mg/ml Oral Suspension 35 ml

- 1. Shake bottle to loosen powder
- 2. Use syringe/measuring cup to measure 24ml of water and add into Fluconazole bottle
 - *Powder may clump be sure to reconstitute all powder well
- 3. Insert bottle adaptor (if applicable) and place cap on bottle
- 4. Shake vigorously
- 5. Use Fluconazole within 14 days. Store at room temperature
- 6. Always shake well prior to administration
