↑↓ ELEVATORS

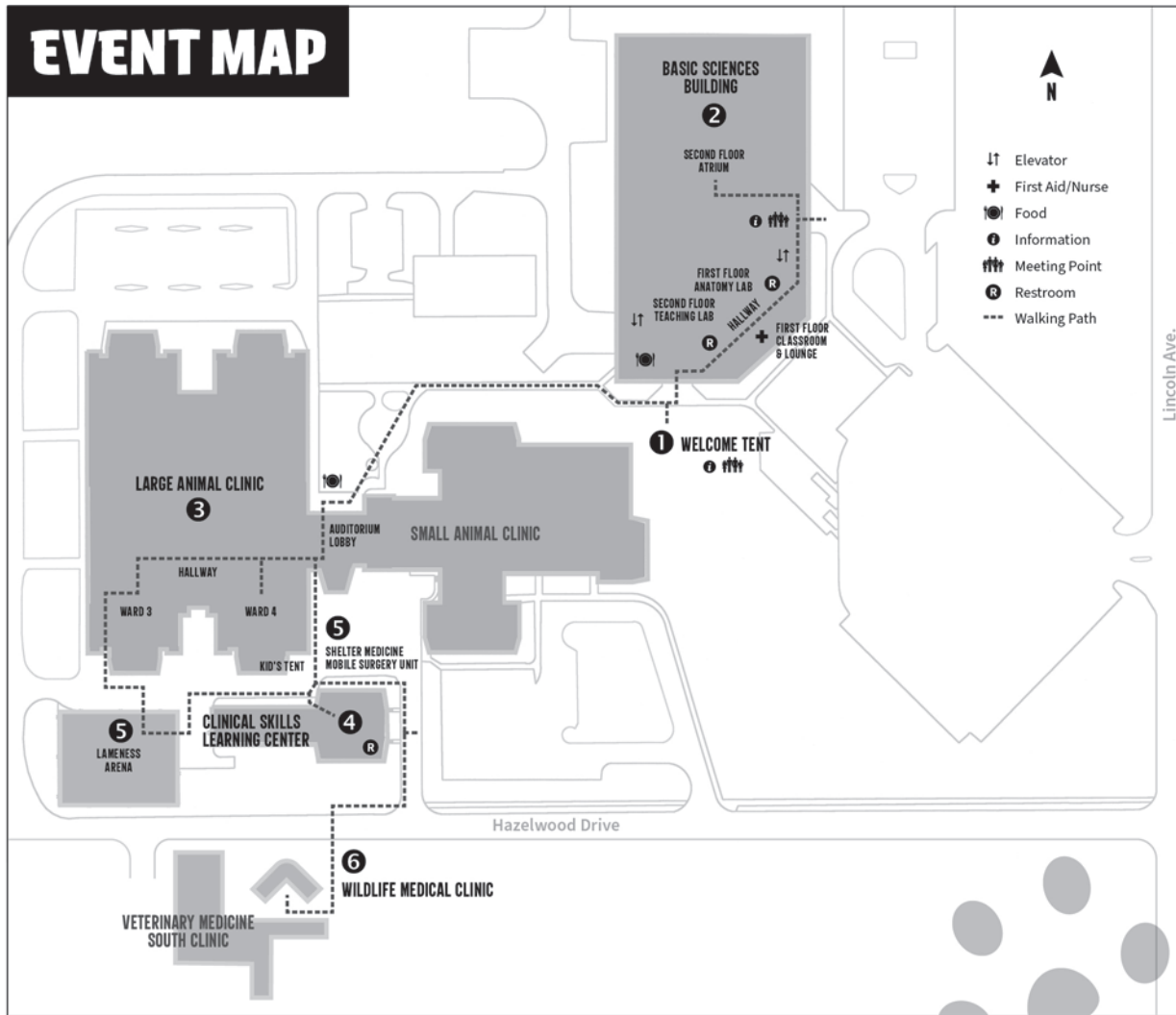
